CELEBRATION MEETING TO BE HELD




FEBRUARY 13, 2015



Quick Tips for Newbie HF DXers:

DX has different meanings for almost everyone. For some it means working California. For others it's France, Italy, or Sweden. To those fortunate enough to be on the DXCC Honor Roll it may be only Scarborough Reef or North Korea. There is room for everyone. These few tips are second nature to the seasoned DXer, but worthwhile for anyone just getting into the world of DX.

Listen...listen...listen. This can't be overemphasized. Don't just call a DX station because you hear others calling him. YOU have to hear him or you'll just be QRM.

If he's working simplex (sending and receiving on the same frequency)' get on his frequency. Not just close, but right on.

Most "everyday" DX is on simplex. But DX-Peditions and really rare DX stations almost always work "split". This allows the "pileup" to always hear him in the clear. Stations working "split" will announce the fact by saying, for example, "EP5T listening up 5". That means he'll be listening 5 kHz above his own frequency.

Listen to how he's operating. Is he going back to callers very quickly? Or is he letting several seconds go by before he goes back. Timing your call can easily make the difference between working a "new one" and going away empty handed.

Use standard phonetics. Alpha, Bravo, Charlie, Delta, etc. Don't get too cute with your phonetics. Call him ONCE and listen for a comeback. Don't just send your callsign over and over. If several seconds pass and the DX station hasn't gone back to anybody, then call him again.

Resist the temptation to shout into the microphone. It won't make your signal go any farther. All it will do is distort your audio.

Speak in an assertive way. Not belligerent or overbearing, just assertive. Don't act like you're nervous or afraid. He won't bite.

From time to time I'll add more tips.

What to watch for in February:

Station K1N will operate during the first two weeks of February from Navassa Island in the Carribbean, not far from Puerto Rico. This is a really rare entity, so go for it!
